This week in Puffin Class

Cooking

All we had to do was whisk two eggs with 1/8 teaspoon of baking powder and stir in mashed banana. We then made small pancakes. All of the children helped to make the pancakes and most tasted them! The adults tasted them too and found them to be really tasty.

Last Friday was our messy art day with Becky. As the school's topic is 'The World Around Us', we asked to do art inspired by Australian Aboriginal art. We looked at a didgeridoo and a dot painting and saw a video on the large screen of an Aboriginal woman painting accompanied by music. The children enjoyed trying out different techniques such as printing with their feet and hands on different materials as well as using a variety of brushes, tubes, sponges etc to print with.
