Wrens Class Newsletter

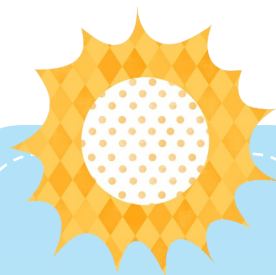
Welcome back everyone! We all hope you enjoyed the week off and made the most of the lovely sunshine!
