

An NHS speech and language therapist who is part of Wiltshire Children's Services is allocated to the school and makes regular weekly visits.

The therapist work with individual pupils and groups of pupils on specific areas of need and completes specialist assessments of pupils' speech and language development. The therapist also provides and monitors programmes that pupils complete with teaching assistants.



In addition the therapist may provide training so that teachers and teaching assistants are empowered to meet the speech and language needs of pupils with complex needs. The school employs an experienced Communication Practitioner to work closely with the speech and language therapist so that specialism and expertise is enhanced within the school.

All children who have an OPEN EPISODE OF CARE for Speech and Language Therapy (SaLT) will have a SaLT Plan and parents will receive a copy of this plan when it is updated. Parents are always welcome to request a review with SaLT. If you would like to arrange this, just let your child's teacher know and the therapist will contact you to arrange an appointment
