To provide relief/cover to contracted Minibus Drivers. Casual work includes conveying pupils on to and from school, mornings and afternoons. Providing personal and physical assistance as required during the course of the journeys. Appropriately supervise pupils during boarding/alighting from vehicles and during the course of the journey so as to ensure safety and security during the course of all journeys. Be a team player in working alongside others to assist pupils with complex behavioural problems.

As required, to attend the routine maintenance of the allocated vehicle (i.e. oil, water and fuel etc.). To undertake routine checks and cleaning of the allocated vehicle ensuring its suitability for driving prior to all journeys. As required to drive minibuses to workshops for repairs and maintenance.
