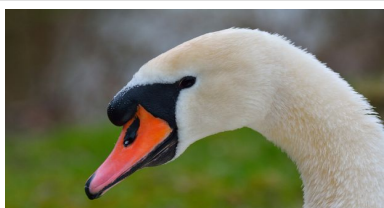
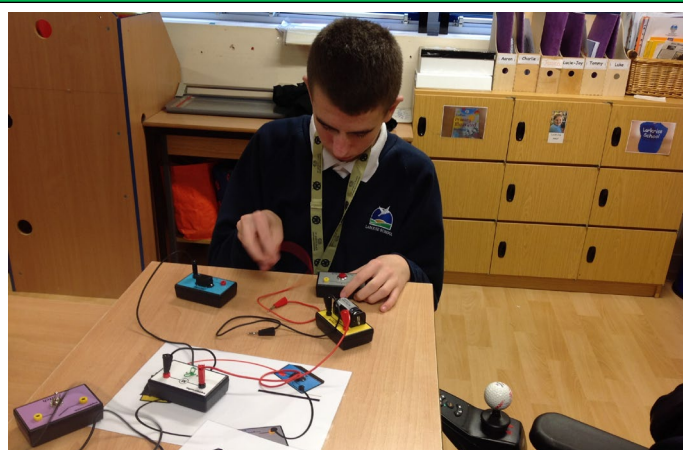


# Swans Weekly News
