This week in Wrens we have continued to learn the story 'Whatever Next.' The children are enjoying this story and have been independently using the props to retell it to themselves and others. As part of our topic about Earth and Space we modelled with grey playdough adding lots of loose parts to make them unique.

We have introduced a range of stimulating items into the class which the children are enjoying using. They are called 'loose parts' and the children are able to use them in anyway they want. For example we have lots of conkers, pine cones and pebbles which they use to count, make patterns with, pour and explore.
