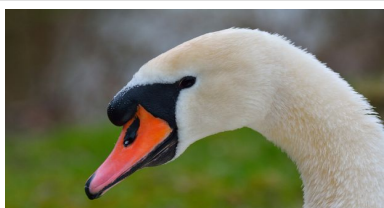


Swans Weekly News
